Mr. Sharawy,

You cannot buy a gauge until you have a license. The vendor cannot send you a gauge until the vendor verifies that you have a license from the NRC or an Agreement State.

You will be assessed an annual fee whether you actually possess a gauge or not. Inspections also will be required regardless of whether or not you possess a gauge, so long as you have a license.
