Dear Mr. Muhich:

On December 23, 2020, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) received an application regarding the proposed license transfer of the Palisades Nuclear Plant, filed by Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc., on behalf of itself, Entergy Nuclear Palisades, LLC, Holtec International, and Holtec Decommissioning International, LLC. Consistent with NRC policy, the NRC staff is currently performing an acceptance review of the application for completeness and acceptability for docketing, and to determine if there is sufficient technical information to allow the NRC staff to complete its detailed technical review.

Should the application be accepted for the detailed review, the NRC will provide public notification of the proposed license transfer through an individual notice in the *Federal Register*, which will include a docket number and information for submitting comments and requesting a hearing on this matter. There will be 30 days to provide comments, and 20 days to request a hearing, as will be indicated in that notice.

While the NRC also expects to hold a public meeting about the decommissioning process for the Palisades Nuclear Plant, any future meeting notices will be placed into the NRC's public meeting schedule.
