Mr. Matt Slaymaker, RSO:

You sent an email on March 20, 2020 to the NRC Region IV licensing assistant requesting to amend NRC license number 15-29301-02 to reformat items 8.A., 8.B., and 8.C. Please note that the current NRC license is written in accordance with information from the corresponding sealed source and device registration certificates demonstrating the compatibility between sealed sources, radiography cameras and source changers. In addition, the NRC license is written in accordance with the Agency approved format from the Web-Based Licensing system. Therefore, your request cannot proceed, and this licensing action has been suspended.

You can submit another amendment request to our licensing assistant ([carol.hill@nrc.gov](mailto:carol.hill@nrc.gov)) using NRC Form 313 and following the NRC licensing guidance described in Appendix C of NUREG-1556, Volume 2, revision 1, provided that you submit copies of the sealed source and device registration certificates demonstrating the compatibility between sealed sources, radiography cameras and source changers listed in items 6.A. through 9.A., 6.B. through 9.B., and 6.C. through 9.C.
