General Comment

ES-1.2, B.3 (pages 1 and 2) outlines times for completing initial and requal examinations. The first paragraph states: "The times allotted for taking each examination noted above shall not be extended except for unavoidable situations (e.g., loss of power, building evacuation, emergency" response). The following paragraph states: "For a requalification examination, the time limit for completing both sections of the examination is 3 hours."

Is the intent that the time for regual exams not be extended as well? if so, the statement of not extending time should either be repeated or modified to state that there are no time extensions for either exams.

Additionally, does the time limit for requal exams only apply for NRC developed requal exams? If a utility procedure states that an extension may be granted, is that acceptable?
