This is in reference to your letter dated December 8, 2020 requesting to amend NRC License No. 07-20696-01. In order to continue our review of your request, the following information is needed:

- 1) Please provide documentation demonstrating that the proposed RSO is qualified by training and experience (e.g., certificate of completion of the RSO's course and/or the authorized user's course). Please refer to NUREG-1556, Volume 4, Revision 1 (Section 8.7), "Response from Applicant" and/or Appendix B "Suggested Format for Providing Information Requested in Items 5 through 11 of U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Form 313" for details. - 2) Please confirm that you wish to add Mr. Collings to License Condition 17.A. of your license and provide an updated list of individuals qualified in accordance with License Condition 17.A.
- 3) Please confirm which address is correct and should be placed in License Condition 10. The address on your amendment request letter (lower left) indicates that the BASF address is 205 N. James St., Newport, DE however, License Condition 10 of your license, indicates that the licensee's facility is located at 205 South James St., Newport, DE.
- 4) Please confirm if Mr. Collings' phone number, listed in the amendment request, is a personal phone number or a BASF business phone number.
- 5) In general, we noted that the amendment request contains some personally identifiable information (PII) (i.e., personal phone number, SSN, a graduation date). In the future, please do not submit PII. Please refer to Section 5 of the NUREG-1556 for details.
