1. On January 15, 2021, in CLI-21-03, the Commission affirmed the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's decision to set aside the immediate effectiveness of the Staff's enforcement order on Mr. Shea. <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/commission/orders/2021/index.html>
2. Upon further review of the facts and in light of the Commission's Order, the Staff is issuing letters rescinding Mr. Shea's Order and Ms. Henderson's Notice of Violation, respectively.
