We hereby serve you notice that an amendment to the complaint filed by Ms. Beth Wetzel (Complainant) has been received by this office alleging continued retaliation in violation of the whistleblower provisions of Section 211 of the Energy Reorganization Act (ERA), 42 U.S.C. §5851 and regulation, 29 CFR Part 24. It is our understanding that a copy of the amended complaint has been provided to you.

We would appreciate receiving from you **within 20 days** a written account of the facts and a statement of your position with respect to the allegation that you have retaliated against Ms. Wetzel in violation of the Act. Please note that a full and complete initial response, supported by appropriate documentation, may help to achieve early resolution of this matter. Voluntary adjustment of complaints can be effected by way of a settlement agreement at any time.

We are also notifying the party named in the complaint about the filing of the complaint and that we are conducting an investigation into your allegations. We are providing the named party with a copy of your complaint and information concerning the Occupational Safety and Health Administration's responsibilities under the law. Upon request, a printed copy of these materials will be mailed to you.

OSHA will provide to you (or to your legal counsel if you are represented by counsel, or to your authorized representative) a copy of all of the respondent's submissions to OSHA that are responsive to your whistleblower complaint. In addition, OSHA will disclose to the parties in this case any other information relevant to the resolution of the case, because evidence submitted by

the parties must be tested and the opposing party provided the opportunity to fully respond. If information provided contains personal, identifiable information about individuals other than you, such information, where appropriate, will be redacted before disclosure.

Attention is called to your right and the right of any party to be represented by counsel or other representative in this matter. In the event you choose to have a representative appear on your behalf, please complete the Designation of Representative form enclosed and forward it promptly.

You are expected to cooperate in the investigation of your complaint and failure to do so may cause your complaint to be dismissed.
