

Dow Chemical Company Response to 2-2-21 RAI

Radioactive asbestos is not mixed waste because asbestos it is not regulated under RCRA. All radioactive wastes, including contaminated non-friable asbestos, will be shipped to the Toxco Materials Management Center (TMMC) in Oak Ridge, TN for processing and disposal. The transportation and disposal costs for radioactive asbestos waste are included in the decommissioning cost estimate.
