I. SECY-20-0087 – HOLTEC INTERNATIONAL (HI-STORE CONSOLIDATED INTERIM STORAGE FACILITY), SIERRA CLUB APPEAL OF LBP-20-6

The Commission¹ approved a Memorandum and Order addressing Sierra Club's appeal of the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board's decision on remand dismissing its five contentions. The Memorandum and Order denies the appeal.
