Below is a summary of Region III's review of a log book entry dated 10/22/2020 by the National Response Center. The Department of Army reported that two pallets of H-3 optical gunsights (100 mci per gunsight) were determined to be missing from the Anniston Army Depot in Anniston, Alabama on 10/21/2020.

Kevin Null worked with NMSS and confirmed that the scopes containing H-3 were received by the military as an exempt product under 30.19 in accordance with an exempt distribution license issued to Trijicon. The loss of the H-3 is not reportable. The DI for reactive inspections does not apply.

Mr. Null followed up with Nathan Krzyaniak, POC for the Army (734-765-7312) re: status of the recovery and determination of what may have happened. The material is still missing and the Army is still investigating. Apparently the H-3 scopes were very old, past their useful life, and were awaiting disposal.
