Good afternoon,

Please review the below wording for the proposed license condition we are prepared to issue for the extension of the decommissioning time frame from 24 months to five years and provide a response if the wording is acceptable.

1. An alternative schedule for permittees for the completion of decommissioning at any permitted site or separate building or outdoor area that do not involve groundwater contamination. Decommissioning shall be completed as soon as practical but no later than five years following the initiation of decommissioning.
2. An alternative schedule for requesting permit termination when decommissioning involves an entire permittee's site and that site does not involve groundwater contamination. The licensee shall request permit termination for an

entire site as soon as practical but no later than five years following the initiation of decommissioning.
