SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JANUARY 21, 2021, MEETING BETWEEN THE

U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION STAFF AND X-ENERGY, LLC TO DISCUSS THE QUALITY ASSURANCE PROGRAM DESCRIPTION FOR THE XE-100 REACTOR

DESIGN CERTIFICATION

On January 21, 2021 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML21008A365), the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a virtual Category 1 public meeting with representatives from X-Energy, LLC (X-Energy) and Energy Northwest. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss X-Energy's Quality Assurance Program Description (QAPD) for the Xe-100 reactor design. The presentation slides can be found at ADAMS Accession No. ML21022A412. The meeting attendees are included as an enclosure to this document.

The meeting began with an overview of the QAPD and the Energy Northwest Quality Assurance program. The accepted XEQAPD-NP-A, "Quality Assurance Program Description" Revision 3-A (ADAMS Accession No. ML20343A088), addresses the quality assuance requirements for a Design Certification application. However, the U.S. Department of Energy selected X-Energy as one of the awardees for its Advanced Reactor Demonstration Program and it is more likely that a site-specific licensing pathway will be utilized. This licensing pathway will be under Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations Part 50, construction permit and operating license or Part 52 for a combined license application.

To address the differences between the licensing pathways, X-Energy is assessing any possible gaps so there is no reduction in commitments. X-Energy plans to submit a revision to the QAPD for clarification purposes and to adequately address all requirements considering the licensing pathway options.

Another topic discussed during the meeting was about the structures, systems, and components (SSCs) classification methodology and the path forward. The Xe-100 QAPD is based on Nuclear Energy Institute's (NEI) previous templates and NRC Regulatory Guide 1.29. X-Energy will revise the QAPD to pursue the SSC safety classification via implementation of NEI 18-04 and Regulatory Guidee 1.233.

As part of the work design, X-Energy is designing the plant such that it can be sited at the Washington Nuclear Project Number 1 site. Energy Northwest leases this site. Energy Northwest has a supporting role at the moment and X-Energy is the near-term lead for the licensing process until Energy Northwest is possibly identified as the applicant.

The meeting ended with an open discussion among the participants. X-Energy and Energy Northwest will continue discussions with NRC staff related to the QAPD and other preapplication activities, as necessary.
