NRC Staff Response to February 9, 2021, Order of the Secretary

On September 13, 2020, Ms. Erin Henderson filed a request for a hearing on the Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to her by the staff of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on August 24, 2020.¹ On January 22, 2021, the NRC Staff rescinded the NOV.² On February 9, 2021, the Secretary of the Commission issued an Order requesting that the parties clarify whether the rescission of the NOV renders the hearing request moot, and whether this adjudicatory matter should be terminated.³ In the NRC Staff's view, the hearing request should be dismissed as moot and the matter terminated.

A case is moot "when the issues are no longer 'live,' or the parties lack a cognizable interest in the outcome." In the instant case, Ms. Henderson sought a hearing on an NOV issued to her. As described in the Staff's answer to Ms. Henderson's request for hearing, it is well established that the NRC does not hold hearings on NOVs. Notwithstanding the lack of
