Subject: Delegation of Authority

You, Karly St. Aubin, have been appointed radiation safety officer and are responsible for ensuring the safe and secure use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the Radiation Protection Program, identifying radiation protection problems, initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions, verifying implementation of corrective actions, stopping unsafe activities, and ensuring compliance with regulations. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of byproduct material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations, when justified, to maintain radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff does not cooperate and does not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission at any time. It is estimated that you will spend up to 20 hours per week conducting radiation protection activities.



Hey Troy,

Good call this afternoon. As discussed, please see the attached Request for Additional Information (RAI). Please note there are 5 items on the RAI. We discussed the first 4 during our earlier call. However, the 5th item is something I added re: Item 16.7 in Att. E – Radiation Safety Manual (RSM). I think this self-imposed requirement to notify NRC annually in writing of the transfers is unnecessary. Just keep records of the transfer/disposal of engines.

If you choose to remove that requirement from your RSM, just update the language in that section in your response to the RAI. THERE IS NO NEED TO RESUBMIT THE ENTIRE RSM.

If you have any questions once you review the RAI, please let me know.

You may provide your response by email. Attach a PDF with a **SIGNED** cover letter in an email back to me and I will add it to the file as necessary. On your response, please mark it as **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION FOR CN623938.**
