Change condition 9.E. to read: For use incident to device installation, removal, relocation, dismantling, alignment, replacement, repair, servicing, packaging, testing the “on-off” mechanisms, collecting leak test samples, performing radiation surveys, and conducting emergency response operations of fixed gauging devices containing licensed material listed in items 6.E.-K. only at customers’ facilities. Integration of licensees control technologies with other manufacturer’s gauging devices containing licensed material listed in items 6.E.-K.

Change condition 9.M. to read: For use incident to device installation, removal, relocation, dismantling, alignment, replacement, repair, servicing, packaging, testing the “on-off” mechanisms, collecting leak test samples, performing radiation surveys, and conducting emergency response operations of fixed gauging devices containing licensed material listed in items 6.M.-X. only at customers’ facilities. Integration of licensees control technologies with other manufacturer’s gauging devices containing licensed material listed in items 6.E.-K.

Change condition 11.B. to read: The Alternate RSOs for this license are Douglas M. Beek and Glenn A. Wrightsman, II.
