SUMMARY AND ACTION REQUIRED (IF ANY) This record concerns the licensee's June 30, 2016 Decommissioning Funding Plan (DFP; NRC Accession No. ML16183A318), submitted to meet requirements listed in Title 10 of the <i>Code of Federal Regulations</i> Section 30.36(e). It also concerns the licensee's (via Zevacor Pharma) September 5, 2017 Surety Bond (SB) and September 20, 2017 Rider (ML17264A971). The conversation was documented on 7/31/2018 by then-MLB-reviewer J. Bishop, to note status of the review. Upon review, then-MLB-reviewer J. Bishop had noted that the DFP - submitted by predecessor entity Zevacor Pharma - was consistent with cost estimate tables provided in previous cost estimates which had been approved. Accordingly, no additional information was needed from the licensee to complete our review of the DFP, as of the date of the referenced conversation. Upon review, however, we noted that changes needed to be made to the SB and that an STA and CFA were required to be provided. In the conversation then-MLB-reviewer J. Bishop discussed those changes and received email responses from Ms. Gunny including copies of a revised SB and of an STA. An updated SB, updated STA, and a CFA were requested via email to Ms. Gunny on 6/26/2018. The review is ongoing, including of updated STA, SB, and CFA received via 7/25/18 letter (ML18215A407) and of updated SB received via 9/10/18 letter (ML18261A338).

Jennifer:

Thank you for your email. Sofie is working on obtaining the original bond and addressing the standby trust agreement issue.

Please note that bonds are live instruments once signed (meaning they can be called upon). As such, the bonding agency prefers sign off before the bonds are issued to make sure that the bond meets your needs and that multiple bonds are not in effect for the same matter at one time. Based on your email below, it appears that you are okay with the language proposed and thus Sofie is working to have the bond issued.

Just as a heads up, the bonding agency will require the NRC to return the existing bond (again – given that it is a live instrument). Sofie is working with the bonding agency with respect to the timing of same. If you have any comments in that regard, please let us know.

One point of clarification - you attached two documents to your email that were not explained below and had not been requested in prior correspondence. One is a "model specimen certificate of events" and the other is the related resolution certification. These seem to relate to a decommissioning request and Sofie is not currently seeking to decommission its cyclotron. Can you please clarify the need for those two documents at this time? Much appreciated.

My name is Deborah Gunny and I am an attorney for Sofie Biosciences, Inc. Thank you for taking my call last week regarding the new bond for license no. 45-25221-05. In response to your letter to Michael Levy:

1. Attached please find a draft of the proposed bond to be issued in lieu of the existing bond. The draft lists the name and address of the entity, includes the docket number and reflects the most recent decommission cost estimate (\$360,821). Please review and confirm that the bond now sets forth the information requested by the NRC (or let us know any further corrections).
2. Last Thursday I sent to you the existing trust agreement under which the attached draft bond would be issued. Please confirm that the company has satisfied that requirement of the NRC.
