Dear Mr. Guss:

By letter dated December 2, 2020, Jubilant DraxImage Radiopharmacies, Inc. (you) submitted to the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a Request for Consent to Direct Change of Control of NRC Material License Nos. 09-32781-01MD, 09-32781-02MD, 09-32781-03MD and 09-32781-04MD. Your letter is available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML20338A439.

Based on the information provided, we understand that as a result of a proposed sale between Jubilant DraxImage Radiopharmacies Inc. d/b/a Jubilant Radiopharma ("JDR") and Jubilant DraxImage Inc. d/b/a Jubilant Radiopharma ("JDI"), control of JDR will directly be transferred to JDI. We further understand that this transfer will not result in any change to the doing-business-as name, licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, location of use of licensed material, or persons responsible for the licensee's radiation safety program.

Based on the above understandings and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report (SER) which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, we have no objection to the proposed transfer. Please note that you will need to notify us promptly, in writing, after the transaction has been finalized and include a signed copy of the sale agreement confirming completion of the transaction. With this information, we can issue an administrative amendment to your NRC license to reflect the transaction, if necessary. If this planned sale has not been consummated within 30 days of the date of this letter, please notify us in writing.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) Section 51.22(c).

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice and Procedure," a copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public
