Dear Mr. Parker:

This letter is to notify you, pursuant to 10 CFR 30.36(d) and Paragraph 36.e., of our Letter of Understanding (LOU) with NRC, that a decision has been made to permanently cease principal activities with NRC-licensed materials, as defined in 10 CFR 30, at an entire site, a VA community based outpatient clinic located at 600 South 70th Street, Lincoln, Nebraska. The facility operated under VHA Permit No. 26-16293-01. The permittee signed the request to terminate the permit on March 8, 2021.

We are working with facility management and the Radiation Safety Officer to terminate the radioactive materials permit, issued under our license, in a timely manner. Based on historically licensed/permitted activities at the site (i.e., medical uses under 10 CFR 35.100, 35.200 and 35.300), we expect the termination efforts will not require a Decommissioning Plan per 10 CFR 30. Therefore, we anticipate completing the review and release of the site under provisions of Paragraph 36.a. of the LOU and will notify NRC when the permit termination process is complete.

To assist with our review, we request a copy of the NRC Docket Files related to this address of use. The permittee previously held NRC License No. 26-16293-01 (Docket No. 030-10748).
