The purpose of this letter is to make notification of conducting temporary work under license# 20-31340-01. Specific information as required by paragraph 15A of the license is provided.

1. The primary radionuclide of concern is Ra-226, solid form, from historical shipyard operations. Estimated quantity is 0.2 Curie.
2. Site is located at Navy Support Activity, Crane Indiana.
3. The overall radiation safety scope of the project is to perform radiological compliance/Health and Safety support of designated excavation and soil characterization surveys at NSA Crane SWMU-21. Radioactive material generated is secured and stored on the Navy property until transferred to Navy contract waste broker for off-site disposition.
4. Project period of performance is from April 15, 2021 to July 31, 2021.
