In April of 2018 St. Luke's Hospital purchased Des Peres Hospital. Written consent from the NRC for transfer of control was received prior to the purchase. The name of Des Peres Hospital was changed to St. Luke's Des Peres Episcopal-Presbyterian Hospital and continued to operate under the original NRC license (NRC License No. 24-32195-01).
