Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 30.34(b), the transferor BASF Color and Effects, USA, LLC and the transferee DIC Corporation ("Sun Chemical") are requesting written approval by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") for the proposed indirect transfer of control of the Newport facility License 07-20696-01.

On the date of the approved transfer of control, the transferee agrees to abide by all commitments, conditions, requirements, and representations identified in the existing facility license as it will remain unaffected by the proposed change in ownership.

The transferee confirms the licensee program requirements which include no open inspection items or any resulting enforcement actions.
