Dear Dr. Foxman:

By the letters dated October 13, 2020, and November 17, 2020, and email dated January 28, 2021, Connecticut Imaging Partners, LLC (CIP) requested written consent by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to a proposed indirect transfer of control of NRC Materials License No. 06-28502-01. Based on the information provided, the NRC understands that Radiology Partners, Inc. acquired Mednax, which provides management services to CIP. Additionally, Jefferson Radiology, P.C. is a co-owner of CIP, and its owner, Dr. Kurt Pickert, M.D., intends to sell his equity interest to Anthony Gabriel, M.D. and Nina Kotter, M.D. in equal shares. Since Jefferson Radiology, P.C. holds negative control of CIP, as evidenced by their operating procedures, the transaction constitutes an indirect change of control. We further understand that this transfer will not result in any changes to the location of use, licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, location of use, or persons responsible for the radiation safety program.

Based on the above understandings, as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report, which documents the NRC staff's safety review of the request, and in accordance with 10 CFR 35.18, the NRC consents to the proposed transfer. Please note that you will need to notify us promptly, in writing, after the transaction has been finalized and include a signed copy of the sale agreement confirming completion of the transaction. Please notify the NRC in writing, if this planned sale has not been consummated within 30 days of the expected transaction date, which is expected to occur following NRC approval, or this consent may be deemed null and void. Future changes in the license's name, licensed use, licensed materials, licensed locations, or persons responsible for licensed material require submission of a request to amend the license. NRC approval must be received prior to implementation of the proposed change.

An environmental assessment for this action was not required because this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(21).
