SUMMARY AND ACTION REQUIRED (IF ANY)				
<p>On 1/8/21, M. Gryglak had a phone discussion with Brian Davidson, RSO for Covance Central Laboratory Services, Inc. regarding the licensee's information in its renewal application dated 10/27/2020 to renew license no. 13-26058-01. Specifically, Ms. Gryglak inquired about the scope of the licensee's program and onsite R&D activities. Mr. Davidson explained that Covance is a contract laboratory. Only H-3 (last use many years ago) and I-125 were used. Currently, the licensee is not using the I-125 kits since the testing has been transferred to another Covance laboratory. The facility has been also processing biological samples (blood, tissue), some with trace amounts of radioactive material (mostly Ra-223, Lu-177, Am-241), which is currently the only activity at the laboratory. The licensee verified by calculations the activities of samples containing traces of radioactivity and determined that they were below the exempt quantities in 10 CFR 30.71 schedule B. Further, the licensee added that the biological samples when being shipped to his facility are not labeled as radioactive material. Therefore, the licensee was seeking some clarification whether a license is needed.</p>
