Good Morning:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission plans to issue an Amendment to Renewed Facility Operating License (RFOL) No. DPR-16 for Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station (Oyster Creek) by the end of June 2021, in response to the Holtec Decommissioning International application dated March 16, 2021 (ADAMS Accession No. ML21075A337).

The proposed amendment would revise the RFOL and the associated Technical Specifications to Permanently Defueled Technical Specifications (PDTs) to reflect the permanently shutdown status of the decommissioning facility, as well as the reduced scope of structures, systems, and components necessary to ensure plant safety once all spent fuel has been permanently moved to the Oyster Creek ISFSI, an activity which is currently scheduled for completion in Summer 2021.
