Dear Mr. Stack:

This is in reference to your letters dated January 25 and April 8, 2021, requesting to amend your license due to a name change, and notifying us of an indirect change of control (company ownership) for NRC License No. 07-17431-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

- Describe the status of your facilities and licensed devices, including any known contamination or leakage of sources, leak test, inventory, training and recordkeeping. If there is known contamination or leakage, confirm the Hull & Associates, LLC has accepted the facilities and equipment "as is".
- 2. Confirm if Duffield Associates, LLC will maintain records important to decommissioning, or if such records will be transferred to Hull & Associates, LLC.
- 3. Confirm that both the Duffield Associates and Hull & Associates, LLC agree to the transfer of control of the licensed material and activity, and the conditions of transfer, and that the Hull & Associates, LLC has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.
- 4. Confirm that Hull & Associates, LLC will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of the license issued to Duffield Associates, Inc. Alternately, Hull & Associates must submit a complete description of the proposed licensed program.
- 5. Confirm if Hull & Associates, LLC possesses an NRC or Agreement State license for similar activities. If so, provide the license number and name of the licensee. If not, provide the name and contact information for an individual at Hull & Associates, LLC that we may contact prior to approval of the indirect transfer of control.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at:

While it is allowable, please refrain from submitting proprietary information in support of a license unless necessary. Keep in mind that all NRC licenses are considered to be in the public domain, and therefore may be viewed by any member of the public who requests to see them.
