committed to implement and maintain.						
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As corrective action for this Severity Level IV violation, the licensee revised its practices for maintenance to						
preclude handling unshielded sources, added revised procedures which reiterated the prohibition on handling						
unshielded sources to all gauge binders, sent a memo to gauge users instructing them to read the revised procedures and reminding them of the prohibition, and committed to include this topic in refresher training.
