Hello,

My name is Kamryn Hartfield, and I am writing in regards to the Northeast Churchrock Uranium Mine. I am writing in solidarity with Members of the Diné community Red Water Pond Road, who are opposing the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA)'s plans to relocate deadly waste from the mine to a location less than a mile from its current location, as well as an undisclosed location. The Red Water Pond Road Community Association and the Navajo Nation declare the plan "insufficient" and "unacceptable."

I am urging the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) to deny General Electric's request for a license amendment to UNC/GE SUA-1475. I, too, believe that the plan is insufficient, as it does not include the documented requests of the Red Water Pond Road community to move the waste out of the area.

I am urging the NRC to work with Navajo Nation EPA Superfund to create a new alternative to move uranium waste out entirely, as safely as possible, and not to other already overburdened communities.

The clean up must be done to the highest standards, including ongoing monitoring of groundwater, air, and soil, and it must be immediate.
