Dr. Heyneman:

The NRC has received your amendment request letter dated May 11, 2021, asking to name Michael Hart as an ARSO (Associate Radiation Safety Officer). ARSOs are not listed in NRC licenses with the exception of 10 CFR Part 35 medical use licenses which do list ARSOs if requested by Part 35 licensees. The Part 35 regulation was recently amended to codify the authorization of ARSOs in medical use licenses. License 11-29216-01MD is a 10 CFR Part 30 nuclear pharmacy license and therefore cannot list an ARSO. You can update your radiation safety program to designate individuals who can act on your behalf as radiation safety officer. Please confirm by reply email that you want to withdraw your May 11, 2021 amendment request.
