SUBJECT: Request for Extension of Licenses #SUB-348 and #29-00047-02 at Picatinny Arsenal, NJ

Ms. Ullrich:

Armaments Center respectfully requests a five-year extension of the current licenses, #SUB-348 and #29-00047-02, for source materials and broad scope research and development. There is no change required at this time to the terms of the licenses which expire November 30, 2021 and April 30, 2022. Since licenses are now being issued for fifteen years instead of ten year periods, a five-year extension of the current licenses would allow for more efficient continuation of operations.
