Dear Dr. Durbin:

This refers to the license amendment request dated March 23, 2021 for NRC Materials License Nos. 24-01570-03 and 24-32195-01. We have reviewed the request and will need the following information.

1. A confirmation that all records required to maintain by NRC regulations in 10 CFR parts 20, 30, and 35 have been transferred from NRC License No. 24-32195-01 to NRC License No. 24-01570-03 (St. Luke's Hospital).
2. A confirmation that all licensed material has been transferred from NRC License No. 24-32195-01 to NRC License No. 24-01570-03.
3. A confirmation that St. Luke's Hospital is aware of all potential contamination, if any, associated with the operations of NRC License No. 24-32195-01 and will accept all responsible for the radiation safety for the facilities and equipment authorized under this license.
4. A confirmation that St. Luke's Hospital has been made aware of any open inspection items and its responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.
5. As the new facility will be added to NRC License No. 24-01570-03, please provide the facility diagram for the location of use located at 2345 Dougherty Ferry Rd., St. Louis, MO 63122. The facility diagram should be submitted in accordance with the guidance listed in "Response from Applicant" in Section 8.9.1, "Facility Diagram" in NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Revision 3. An electronic copy of this guidance can be obtained from the NRC's website at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v9/index.html>.

To continue review of your application, we request that you submit your response in writing with date and signature within 30 calendar days from the date of this correspondence. In your response, please refer the license number, docket number and Mail Control No. 625044. We will assume that you do not wish to further pursue this licensing action if we do not receive a reply within the specified timeframe noted above.
