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Dear Mr. Carlson:

We have reviewed the amendment request dated March 29, 2021 for NRC License No. 13-32775-01 for Pinnacle Heart Specialist, LLC. We will need additional information.

Based on 10 CFR 35.24(g) and Section 8.7.1, "Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) and Associate Radiation Safety Officer (ARSOs)" of NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Revision 3 (an electronic copy of the licensing guidance could be downloaded from the NRC's website at <https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v9/index.html>), please provide the following.

- A description of how the consultant-RSO will allocate time to permit the performance of the duties of the RSO, as described in the regulations. State the consultant-RSO's minimum amount of onsite time (hours per week or days per quarter, as appropriate for the size of the program).
- Identify an in-house representative who will serve as the point of contact during the RSO's absence. (Note: this person may be allowed to assist the consultant RSO in his or her duties. Any such duties should be clearly defined.)
- Describe the overall availability of the consultant-RSO to respond to questions or operational issues that arise during the conduct of the radiation safety program and related regulatory requirements.
- Specify the maximum amount of time it will take the consultant RSO to arrive at the facility, in the event of an emergency that requires his or her presence.

To continue review of your application, we request that you submit your response with date and authorized signature to this correspondence within 30 calendar days from the date of this email. In your response, please refer the license number, docket number and Mail Control No. 625041. We will assume that you do not wish to further pursue this licensing action if we do not receive a reply within the specified timeframe noted above.
