This refers to your request to amend your license dated April 19, 2021. In order to continue our review of your request, the following additional information is needed:

Section 8.7.4 Authorized Medical Physicists of NUREG 1556, Vol 9 Rev. 3 Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses Program Specific Guidance About Medical Use Licenses, provides information on what to submit for approval of Authorized Medical Physicists (AMP). Prior to adding individuals as an AMP licensees must provide training and experience specified in [10 CFR 35.51\(c\)](#) demonstrating that the proposed AMP is qualified by training in the types of use for which the licensee seeks approval of an individual as AMP, including hands-on device operation, safety procedures, clinical use, and operation of a treatment planning system. The State of Maryland license provided to support the addition of Kaile Li, Ph. D. as an AMP does not include the current model HDR listed on your license. Please either provide documentation of the model specific training. Otherwise, we can list the requested individual under condition 12C until the required documentation has been submitted to support addition as an AMP for this model HDR.

Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter. The letter may be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email (preferred); or it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269; or it may be sent by regular mail. If we do not receive a reply from you within 30 calendar days from the date of this e-mail, we will assume that you do not wish to pursue your amendment request.
