PROCEEDINGS

CHAIRMAN HANSON: Good morning. Before we begin today's Commission meeting on Transformation activities here at the NRC, I call to order a Commission affirmation session.

The first item is SECY-21-0048 – FirstEnergy Companies and TMI-2 Solutions, Limited Liability Corporation, Three Mile Island Nuclear Stations, Units 1 and 2), Motion to Hold the Proceeding in Abeyance. The Commission is being asked to act on a Memorandum and Order addressing the motion by Eric Epstein, Chairman of Three Mile Island Alert, Incorporated to hold the license transfer of Three Mile Island Unit 2 in abeyance.
