1. In regards to Room 277, please confirm that you will perform surveys in accordance with Part 20.1501 and Part 35.70 to ensure the public dose limits in Part 20.1301 are met. Further, if necessary to meet the public dose limits, please confirm that you will have portable shielding or removable barriers in place to meet limits.
