Mr. Johnson;

From the response to my request for additional information dated June 16, 2021 I understand that the NRC license for Cottage Grove Cardiology PC "will no longer be needed and may be closed." In order to continue our review the following additional information is required:

1. Please confirm you wish to terminate NRC License No. 06-30260-01;
2. Please provide the following:
 - a. results of surveys made for radiation levels in milliroentgen per hour (mR/hr) and of wipe test surveys made for removable contamination in disintegrations per minute per 100 square centimeters (dpm/100 cm²),
 - b. the manufacturer, model number, and sensitivity of the survey instruments used to perform these measurements, and
 - c. confirmation that all sealed sources possessed and used under the license have been transferred to another licensee authorized to possess them or transferred to a licensed low-level radioactive waste facility.
3. When a licensee terminates licensed activities or licensed activities are transferred to another licensee, the regulations in 10 CFR 30.35(g) require that records of information important to decommissioning be transferred to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission or to a successor licensee to ensure their long-term availability. Please transfer the following records, as were applicable to your program, that pertain to:
 - a. the decommissioning of your facility including records of burials; and
 - b. records of offsite releases and waste disposal including effluent releases, release to sewers, incineration, and radioactive material spills.

Records may be transferred to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I, 2100 Renaissance Blvd., Suite 100, King of Prussia, Pennsylvania 19406, or to the new licensee if licensed activities will continue at the same location under another Commission license.

No transfers or changes of ownership or license terminations will be authorized unless all records considered important to the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility in 10 CFR 30.35(g), 40.36(f), 70.25(g), and 72.30(d); have been transferred to the person continuing the licensed activity, or to the Commission for

license terminations.
