Dear Mr. Rosenbeck:

In the application dated March 17, 2021, you contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate your NRC radioactive material license. The NRC staff has reviewed the information provided. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facilities located at 3915 Research Park Dr. 220, Ste. A-2, Ann Arbor, Michigan, 48108, and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 34-26553-02 is hereby terminated.
