As of April, 29, 2021, FMRI, Inc has changed its name to Fansteel Metals Inc.

The reason for the change is as follows.

FMRI Delaware charter was deactivated during the Fansteel bankruptcy proceeding. When FMRI contacted the Delaware Secretary of State's Office ("DE SOS") to reactivate by paying the past due franchise fee, it advised that there was already a new company whose name was close to FMRI. Accordingly, the DE SOS would not re-activate FMRI so we had to change its name. We did that and changed it to Fansteel Metals, Inc. and paid the past amount due. Ownership remains with Fansteel so that has not changed.

In accordance with the provisions of Part 40 Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulation, the licensee requests to amend its license (SMB 911) to change its name as indicated above. The name change is purely administrative in nature.

In addition to this name change, the licensee requests that all completed conditions in the license be closed and removed from the license based on completion.


