Dear Mr. Anderson:

We have reviewed your letter dated June 10, 2021 and appreciate your comments regarding our proposed license condition. We would like to submit this revision to the license condition for approval.

Revised license condition:

*When complying with the requirements in NAC 459.3062, which adopts 10 CFR 35 by reference, the licensee shall evaluate all events listed in 10 CFR 35.3045 and 10 CFR 35.3047 to determine if the event is reportable. In addition to the reporting requirements specified in 10 CFR 35.3045 and 35.3037, if the licensee determines that an event is not reportable, the licensee shall within 30-days after discovery of the event submit in writing to the Radiation Control Program a description of the event, the evaluation, and any corrective actions implemented to prevent reoccurrence.*
