SUBJECT: U.S. NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION STAFF APPROVAL OF
CAMPSCO, INC. REQUEST FOR 30-DAY EXTENSION OF DUE DATE FOR
PAYMENT OF CIVIL PENALTY PURSUANT TO ORDER, DOCKET NO. 030-
36619, LICENSE NO. 04-23910-01E.

Dear Mr. Slodowitz:

On June 3, 2021, the NRC issued an Order¹ imposing a civil penalty in the amount of \$75,000 (Order) to CampCo, Inc. (CampCo) related to violations of several regulatory and licensing requirements. The Order stated that if payment of the civil penalty as a lump sum in the required timeframe would pose a financial hardship, CampCo may contact NRC to determine if it may qualify for a payment plan over time.

As required by the Order, payment of the civil penalty is due (in full, unless prior arrangements have been made for a signed payment plan agreement with NRC) within 30 days from the date of the Order. In addition, the Order stated that the NRC would consider a request for additional time, if appropriate, and that if CampCo required additional time it must submit a request in writing to the NRC.

On June 18, 2021, CampCo contacted the NRC staff via email to request information regarding payment of the civil penalty in installments. CampCo representatives and the NRC staff held a conference call on July 1, 2021, to discuss available payment options. On July 1, 2021,² CampCo requested additional time to make arrangements for a payment plan agreement with the NRC and also confirmed the option CampCo had selected for the civil penalty payment method.

Based on the information above and pursuant to Section V of the Order, CampCo has shown good cause for extending the time to respond to the Order and I am granting an extension of the civil penalty payment deadline until August 2, 2021.
