Memo to: Radiation Safety Officer
From: Chief Executive Officer
Subject: Delegation of Authority

You, Joshua Kaplan, have been appointed Radiation Safety Officer and are responsible for ensuring the safe use of radiation. You are responsible for managing the radiation protection program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, or providing corrective actions; verifying implementation of corrective actions; stopping unsafe activities; and ensuring compliance with the rule. You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet those responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of radioactive material by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and shutting down operations where justified by radiation safety. You are required to notify management if staff do not cooperate and do not address radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the Virginia Department of Health, Radioactive Materials Program at anytime. It is estimated that you will spend 10 hours per week conducting radiation protection activities.
