SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR AMENDMENT OF LICENSE NO. 45-23645-01NA

The Navy's radioactive materials program is licensed with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) under Master Materials License (MML) Number 45-23645-01NA. The Department of the Navy (DON) formally requests to amend Condition 10 of the MML by deleting subparagraph (9) following the completion of decontamination (Group 3 decommissioning) of Building 200, Bay 4, and outside areas at Naval Surface Warfare Center Dahlgren Division, Dahlgren, Virginia.

The DON has reviewed the Final Status Survey Report for Building 200, Bay 4, and outside areas at Naval Surface Warfare Center, Dahlgren Division, Dahlgren, Virginia and determined that the facility complies with Title 10 Code of Federal Regulations Part 20.1402 for unrestricted release.
