SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Dear Mr. Clements:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) has received a letter dated June 18, 2021, from Wood Environment & Infrastructure Solutions, Inc., requesting to amend NRC license number 05-27748-01 to change the radiation safety officer (RSO). Before we can take further action, we will need the following additional information.

1. Demonstrate that the RSO has sufficient independence and direct communication with responsible management officials by providing a copy of an organizational chart by position and demonstrating day-to-day oversight of the radiation safety activities.
2. Confirm that the RSO will be available for emergencies and can be on-site within 24-48 hours.

To continue review of your application, we request that you submit your response to this letter within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter. In your response, please refer to the docket and control number specified below. We will assume that you do not wish to further pursue this licensing action if we do not receive a reply within the specified timeframe noted above. You can contact me at 817-200-1189 if you have any questions or require additional time to respond.
