Could you provide me with any information regarding the proposed new RSO's experience with tritium and carbon 14 and other low-energy beta emitters? Although he has significant experience with medical uses, those material are usually gamma emitters and surveys etc for them are quite different than the materials that are authorized on the USUHS license.

Really, the medical authorized user form does not provide the information that we need for the range of radionuclides that are listed on your broad scope license. The Part 35 requirements are usually not applicable to the R&D licenses, although all training is helpful.
