Subject: Delegation of Authority

You, Andrew Borrok, Pharm.D., have been appointed Radiation Safety Officer and are now responsible for ensuring the safe use of radioactive materials as used under the Nuclear Regulatory Commission License. As provided for in the license, you are responsible for managing the radiation protection program; identifying radiation protection problems; initiating, recommending, and/or providing corrective action(s) verifying implementation of any such corrective action(s); stopping unsafe activities and practices; and ensuring compliance with all regulations pertaining to the use and handling of radioactive materials.

You are hereby delegated the authority necessary to meet these responsibilities, including prohibiting the use of radioactive materials by employees who do not meet the necessary requirements and ceasing operations where justified by radiation safety. You are required to notify management of situations where staff is not cooperating and addressing radiation safety issues. In addition, you are free to raise issues with the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission at any time.
