The Illinois Emergency Management Agency (IEMA/Agency) appreciates the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for its timely adjudication of our June 4, 2021 comments letter (ADAMS Accession No. ML21166A206) on the Draft Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact for the Morris Operation Decommissioning Funding Plan (EA). IEMA has conducted a second round of reviews on both the EA and the GE Hitachi Nuclear Ener Americas, LLC, Morris Operation Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation, Decommissioning Funding Plan, Revision 5 (ADAMS Accession No. ML21168A260). Based on this review, IEMA finds no basis to oppose the NRC's Finding of No Significant Impact.
