We would like to request an amendment to Liberty Hospital's Radioactive Materials License as follows:


Liberty Hospital would like to delete depleted Uranium from our License # 24-16178-01, as we no longer have a need for it.

Liberty Hospital requested a license for depleted Uranium in anticipation for the use of Cs-137 sources as transmission sources for coincidence imaging.

Although Liberty Hospital has records of receipt of Cs-137 sources from Isotope Products Laboratories (IPL), we have no records of receipt of depleted Uranium from IPL nor are we in possession of depleted Uranium.

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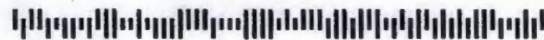
