The Maryland Department of the Environment (Department) recently completed the Integrated Materials Performance Evaluation Program, which included an in-depth review of Maryland's license conditions. It was identified that Maryland is using nonstandard license conditions which need to be reviewed for compatibility with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission license conditions. Enclosed is a copy of Maryland's nonstandard license conditions and the justification for their use. These conditions are legally binding requirements according to COMAR 26.12.01.01, Regulations for the Control of Ionizing Radiation (1994).

The Department believes that adoption of these conditions satisfies the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200.
