Hi David,

One additional follow-up question for you. Your original submittal talks about Chevron doing their own leak tests, but then talks about using wipe test kits from Tracerco. I want to be sure I understand what you are asking for. I did not interpret that you want a change to your license, which currently authorizes you to collect leak test samples but not to analyze the leak test samples. Do you want authorization for analyzing them? If so, you will need to either commit to the following statement "We will implement the model leak test program in Appendix I of NUREG-1556, Volume 4, Revision 1, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Fixed Gauge Licenses." Records of leak tests will be maintained" or indicate that alternative equipment and/or procedures will be used and provide the procedures and indicate that records of leak tests will be maintained.
