On May 5 2021, a letter was sent to notify the NRC that the Anheuser-Busch, LLC. St. Louis Brewery and Corporate Complex, General License Number GL-700118-24, located at One Busch Place, St. Louis, MO 63118, performed the following:

On Wednesday, April 21, 2021, Filtec personnel removed two radioactive source serial numbers 4379 LQ and 4380 LQ, each containing 300 mCi of AM-241, from Industrial Dynamics Model number FT-100/6/CI Serial Number 40286. These sources were returned to Industrial Dynamics.
