SUBJECT: Reply to a Notice of Violation Request to Withhold Information from Public Disclosure Pursuant to 10 CFR 2.390

Century Inspection, Inc. ("Century") is submitting the enclosed reply to two Notices of Violation issued to Century by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") by letter dated July 20, 2021 (the "NOV Letter"). Because one such notice was designated by the NRC as a non-public Notice of Violation, and per the instructions in the NOV Letter, Century has marked its entire response as Security-Related Information not for public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390(d)(1).

In accordance with NRC regulations, Century is enclosing two versions of its reply. A confidential (non-redacted) copy of the reply and its attachments, not for public disclosure, is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**. A non-confidential (redacted) copy of the reply and its attachments, which may be disclosed to the public, is attached hereto as **Exhibit B**. As stated in the NOV Letter, the NRC has waived the affidavit requirements for designating this response for withholding.

As a result of the foregoing, Century asks that the NRC grant this request and withhold the Security-Related Information from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390.
